## Head Start Program Options

### **Head Start Half Day & Full Day-**

- 3-5 year olds
- 5 days per week
- 4 or 6.5 hours per day
- Head Start provides transportation in a limited area (for 6.5 hour program)
- Free for eligible families
- Part-year services provided

### **Head Start Full Day -**

(Parents must be employed or in training with no caregiver in the home.)

- 3-5 year olds
- 5 days per week up to 10 hours per day
- Parent transport
- Child Care Assistance required
- Year round services provided
